

GUIDE FOR PLAY FOOTBALL REGISTRATION

All players must register on Play Football to be eligible to play for an SJSA team for the 2018 season.

Please follow the following instructions to register:

LOGIN

1. Go to the Play Football website: www.playfootball.com.au
2. Click on the "Register Now" tab
3. Choose the option that best suits you
4. If you are a returning player & you know your FFA number & password, choose option 1
5. If you are a returning player but don't know your FFA number or password, choose option 2
6. If you are a new player & have never registered before choose option 3.
If you are a new player after making your FFA number, you must then proceed to register

START REGISTRATION

7. Click on "Register Now".
8. Check that your contact details are correct.
9. All players playing in age groups Under 12 & above must upload a photo with their registration.
Make sure your photo is recent and appropriate.
Registrations with in-appropriate photos will be rejected!
Photos must be a passport style photo from the shoulders up with no hats or sunglasses.
10. Make sure the mandatory fields have been entered and click "Next".
11. Step 1: Type **Shepparton Junior Soccer Association**.
(If you get a message saying there are no packages then click OK and check the club name.)
12. Step 2: Choose "Player".
13. Step 3: Select the correct Registration Package that applies to your school/club team.
14. Click "Add Package" then "Next".
15. Answer the Yes/No question at the top. Read and acknowledge all the Terms and Conditions then click Next.
16. Select "Manual Payment at Club" button to pay at your school/club registration nights.
17. Answer the questions on the last page and click the "Save All Answers" button.
Your registration has now been submitted.
